

TERMS & CONDITIONS FOR ALL UKFA CLASSES & LOCATIONS

WEATHER POLICY

There will be no class if the Typhoon 8 or Black Rainstorm warnings are up / in place.

Classes will proceed in all other conditions (at the discretion of UKFA). If we cancel class because we feel the weather is too bad (or is scheduled to be too bad) then we will inform parents of this via the WhatsApp group. No message means class is proceeding as normal.

If you do not send your child to class, even though class is going ahead, then no make-up class will be provided.

If we need to cancel a class then a make-up class can be scheduled, just reach out to us to organize a date that works for you.

WHAT TO BRING / WEAR

Players must wear the full UKFA kit & shinpads. If players do not wear shinpads they won't be allowed to participate for their own safety. No jewelry, and this includes watches.

Bring plenty of water to every session. Please also have a rain jacket packed just to be safe.

Bring a football to every class. The football must be the correct size otherwise this can harm player development. **Correct Football Sizes:**

(Born 2015 or after) - Size 3

(Born 2012-2014) - Size 4

(Born 2011 or before) - Size 5

SICKNESS / INJURY / MAKE-UP CLASSES

If your child is sick / injured, please let us know ASAP and send us a copy of the doctors note, then we can offer you a make-up class. If your child doesn't go to school that day, please let us know in the morning, not 30 minutes before the class.

Please note – we will only offer a make-up class with a doctor's note or valid proof.

If you do not inform us prior to class that your child isn't attending, then no make-up class will be given.

Make-up classes will only be for sickness or injury. If you miss class for any other reason, we cannot provide a make-up class.

If you have scheduled a make-up class and do not attend it will count as used, it will not be rescheduled because you forgot.

Make-up classes must be done prior to the end of the term & cannot be transferred to the next term or camps (unless the UKFA owner says its ok) and make ups cannot be refunded or the cost cannot be deducted from future terms fees (unless the UKFA owner says its ok).

PAYMENT / REFUND

Fees must be paid in full on or before the child's first class of the term. If you withdraw your child from the classes during the term no refund or credit will be given unless it's agreed to with the UKFA management, but this is at the discretion of UKFA.

VENUE RULES / INFO

Everyone (UKFA staff, players, parents etc) must treat all venues with the utmost respect and care. Anyone not following the basic rules or displaying poor behavior that risks UKFA's use of the facilities will be removed from all UKFA classes immediately without refund.

Shrewsbury – 1 guardian must be present. You must remain in the sport hall. You must not walk around the school. Everything other than the sports hall is off limits.

FTC – Please watch from the side of the pitch, do not walk through or stand/sit on the pitch.

PARENTS AT VENUES

If you wish to attend, you are welcome. Please feel free to cheer & encourage. But we kindly ask that you sit back and relax & enjoy the development process. **Do not coach you child or the other kids**. Your child should be listening to the Coach and their teammates and that's it. Too many voices are a distraction and cause confusion. Anyone overstepping the boundaries will be reminded once, but if it continues, we will ask that you do not attend the classes. Please remember to remain off the pitch too. Respect the Coaches and player's space.

CHANGES TO THE SCHEDULE

There may be times venues become unavailable or we need to change the time / location through no fault or our own. We will try to ensure this never happens, but if it does please be understanding and work with us.
